### **GroupCalendar Server for Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2011 Prerequisites**

#### Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 (Full) is required

The full version of Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 is required. Client Runtime is not sufficient.

#### Supported CRM Versions

Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2011 RTM On-Premise Version 5.0.9688.583

#### **Windows Identity Foundation**

Will be installed as part of the GroupCalendar Server Setup;

#### **Supported Operating Systems**

Windows Server 2008 64bit Windows Server 2008 R2 64bit

#### **IIS 7 required**

GroupCalendar will create a new Website on your IIS 7, IIS 7 must be present on the OS GroupCalendar is installed

### **Installation Notes**

You have to install the **GroupCalendar Server for Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2011** on your Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2011 Server.

During the installation, you have to specify at least one organization in which the GroupCalendar Server will be installed. After the setup is completed, you could start the GroupCalendar Server Configuration in the Windows Start-menu to install and configure the GroupCalendar Server for another CRM organization.

In an **On-Premise** environment, you have to install the "Server Part" on the CRM Server.

## Uninstall

If you want to completely uninstall the GroupCalendar Server for Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2011 for all CRM organizations, just start the uninstall routine through Windows Programs and Features.

If you want to uninstall the GroupCalendar Server for Microsoft Dynamics CRM 2011 for one specific CRM organization, launch the GroupCalendar configuration and remove the product from the desired organization:
