



## DocumentsCorePack vs. Out-of-the-box Dynamics 365

Microsoft Dynamics 365 CE comes with a basic functionality to generate documents via Word templates.

This overview provides a comparison of those native capabilities vs. DocumentsCorePack for Dynamics 365 and Power Apps. Starting with key differences you will find a detailed comparison covering:

- Document Processing & Delivery
- Template Design & Management
